**VOTING OPTIONS**  
**2020 PARTISAN PRIMARY ELECTION**

**Hello voters!** Did you know you have several options on how to cast your ballot for the August 11, 2020 election (and every election).

For the traditional voter who enjoys the excitement of Election Day, polls will be open from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm at Lebanon Town Hall. Our election workers will be happy to assist you along with keeping the election facility as clean and safe as possible. Extra efforts will be taken to continually wipe down voting booths and election equipment throughout the day. For voters' convenience, hand sanitizer will be available.

Not up for Election Day? Request an absentee ballot online at [www.myvote.wi.gov](http://www.myvote.wi.gov) prior to August 6<sup>th</sup>, and a ballot will be mailed to you. Voters may also request a mailed ballot by writing to the Town Clerk but be sure to include a copy of your photo ID with your request. This works great for travelers; those who have a suppressed immune system; or voters who just can't make it to the Town Hall during working hours. Please be sure to allow mailing time so the ballot is returned on or before Election Day.

Voters can also vote in-person via absentee ballot at the Clerk's Office at the Town Hall prior to Election Day. Stop in when the Clerk is at the office or call her to make an appointment. In-person voting ends on Sunday, August 9<sup>th</sup> so plan ahead.
